

**TAX DECLARATION (GIFT AID)**

I would like Collegium Musicum of London ('the Choir') to reclaim tax from the Inland Revenue in respect of all donations paid by me to the Choir since 5th April 2000. I confirm that I am resident in the United Kingdom and that I pay enough tax to the Inland Revenue to cover the tax reclaimed by all the charities or Community Amateur Sports Clubs (CASCs) that I donate to in any one tax year. This includes Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax, tax under PAYE and tax deducted from bank interest (other taxes such as VAT and Council Tax do not qualify).

1. Please note payment by cheque or by internet banking is much preferred to cash payment wherever possible. The Choir cannot reclaim tax on cash payments unless they are clearly identified and recorded as coming from you.
2. You can cancel this request at any time, and must do so if in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay sufficient tax to cover tax reclaimed on your donations. Please also let us know any future changes in your details.
3. At present tax rates, the tax reclaimable by the Choir amounts to £2.82 for every £10 paid in donations. You can take account of capital gains tax as well as income tax liabilities. Please note that if you pay tax at a rate higher than the basic rate you will be entitled to additional tax relief in respect of payments on which the Choir can reclaim tax: this is dealt with through your own tax return, but you will need to keep adequate records of the payments you have made to the Choir .
